Couples and Addiction Recovery is a new workshop for therapists, counselors, recovery coaches, and professionals who work with couples struggling with addiction as well as couples in recovery from alcohol, drugs, and/or behavioral addictions. The training teaches a relationship approach to healing - one that includes an emphasis on recovery for the partner with the substance use disorder, the partner's recovery, and their relationship recovery.

The tools and interventions taught in this workshop are adapted from the Gottman Method to help couples increase communication and understanding, establish appropriate boundaries, and heal from the impact of addiction. The workshop provides opportunities to observe the techniques and exercises, through live and video demonstrations so participants feel ready to use them right away with individual couples and small groups.
